He is currently the President of the Bangladesh Agricultural Economists Association. He was also the senior Vice-President of the Bangladesh Economic Association. He stood first in the first class in Bachelor and Masters degrees in Agricultural Economics from the Bangladesh Agricultural University, Mymensingh.

Professor Mandal did his PhD from University of London and post-doc studies from University of Oxford. He has travelled widely across the world and took part in many national and international seminars and policy forums. He published large number of research papers, reports, books and popular articles on agriculture and rural development.

Life-Sketch of Vice-Chancellor Professor Dr. M. A. Sattar Mandal

Professor Dr. Md. Abdus Sattar Mandal was born in May 1949. He is the eldest of three sons and three daughters of his father late Abdul Gafur Mandal and mother late Sahera Khatun. An extraordinarily meritorious student from his boyhood, Professor Mandal passed his Secondary School Certificate (Humanities) examination under Dhaka Board in 1965 and was placed in the first division with distinction in Islamic Studies. He enrolled as an undergraduate student in the Faculty of Agricultural Economics & Rural Sociology, Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU), Mymensingh in 1965. He obtained his Bachelor and Masters degrees in Agricultural Economics in 1972 and 1974 respectively, securing first position in the first class in both the examinations.

Professor Mandal joined the Department of Agricultural Economics of the Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU), Mymensingh as a Teaching Fellow in 1973 and then as a Lecturer in the same Department in 1974. He was made a Professor of Agricultural Economics in the same Department in 1992.

Professor Mandal was awarded a Commonwealth scholarship to study at the Imperial College London (former Wye College), England and obtained his Ph.D. degree in Agricultural Economics from the University of London in 1979. He was also awarded a Commonwealth academic staff fellowship for a one-year post-doctoral study at the Institute of Agricultural Economics of the University of Oxford in 1987-88. He was awarded the Chancellor's prize and the Nazmul Memorial Gold Medal in recognition of his distinguished academic and co-curricular achievements. He was awarded the best article prize in Social Science in the 19th Bangladesh Association for Advancement of Science (BAAS) conference in 1997. He has so far in his credit 73 published papers, 10 books and monographs, 44 research reports and seminar papers and huge number of popular articles.

In his long outstanding academic career, Professor Mandal amply demonstrated his administrative and managerial competencies as Head of the Department of Agricultural Economics, Dean of the Faculty of Agricultural Economics & Rural Sociology, Member of the Bangladesh Agricultural University Syndicate, Member of the Committee for Advanced Studies & Research (CASR), and Member of the Bangladesh Agricultural University Research System (BAURES) and Convener/ member of many academic and administrative committees. He was the Editor of the Bangladesh Journal of Agricultural Economics and a member of the International Journal of Irrigation and Drainage System for many years.

An internationally eminent agricultural economist, Professor Mandal was appointed as a Member of the Bangladesh Planning Commission for 2000 and 2001 in charge of General Economics Division as well as Agriculture, Water Resources & Rural Institutions Division. He led the preparation of the Mid-term Review of the Fifth Five-Year Plan of Bangladesh and presented it to the National Economic Council meeting in January 2001. His major contribution in the Planning Commission also includes the preparation and publication of an economic update, 'Performance of Bangladesh Economy: 1991- 2001'. Besides providing policy guidelines to the government in different capacities, Professor Mandal also served as a member of Bangladesh delegation in various high profile meetings of the World Bank, Asian Development Bank, FAO, DFID, ILO and many other development partners at home and abroad.

Professor Mandal made significant contribution as a Lead Expert to the preparation of many mainstream national policy documents of the government, including the Country Position Paper on Food Security for the SAARC Region in 2007, Synthesis of Agricultural Policies in 2006, Bangladesh Fishery Research Vision- 2015 in 2006, Poverty Reduction Strategy Paper in 2005, National Agriculture Policy in 1999, Agricultural Sector Review in 1988, Flood Action Plan-12 & 13 in 1991.

His recent contribution of the keynote paper for the World Food Day seminar 2008 has been highly acclaimed for the recommendations suggested for the formulation of agricultural development strategy of Bangladesh in the context of national food security.

Professor Mandal established his academic constituencies in and outside the university. Among others, he served as member of the BRRRI Board of Management, President nominated member of the Jahangirnagar University Academic Council, and member of national steering committee for preparing the Agriculture Sector Review, member of the Agricultural Economics Board of Studies of Bangobandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Agricultural University, President of the International Water Management Institute Research Network on Irrigation Management for Crop Diversification. He was a visiting Professor at the University of East Anglia, UK, Rutgers University, USA, Bidhan Chandra Krishi Viswavidyalaya, India and University of Life Sciences, Norway. At present, Professor Mandal is a Trustee Board member of the Bangladesh Rice Foundation and a member of the Board of Governors of the BAU Institute of Agribusiness Management. Currently, Professor Mandal has been involved as an Adviser to the Cornell University- International Food Policy Research Institute- Wageningen University- Copenhagen University consortium to design and run undergraduate and post-graduate study programmes on global food policy for the developing countries. He is also contributing as a lead resource person for the cross-cutting research on Groundwater Governance in Asia run by the International Water Management Institute, Colombo.

Professor Mandal left behind a distinguished track record in co-curricular activities of this university. An articulate debater and reciter of poem, he won the championship prizes in the literary competitions of the university for several years. He secured the runner up prize in the All Pakistan Inter-university Debate Competition held in Lahore, Pakistan in 1970, and in the Inter-university Debate Competitions held at the BUET in 1973 and at BAU in 1974. He was also awarded the BAU 25th UNESCO Day Essay Competition prize in 1971.

Professor Mandal, by dint of his organizational ability and leadership quality, was elected Literary Secretary of the then East Pakistan Agricultural University Central Students' Union in 1966, General Secretary of the Bangladesh Agricultural University Teachers' Association in 1981, senior Vice-President of the Bangladesh Association for Advancement of Science Council in 1996, President of the Bangladesh Agricultural Economists Association in 2000, Bangladesh Representative to the International Association of Agricultural Economists in 2000, and senior Vice-President of the Bangladesh Economic Association in 1996, 2002 and 2004. As the University Correspondent of the daily Ittefaq, he was the President of the BAU Journalists Association in 1974-1975. He is currently the President of the Bangladesh Agricultural Economists Association for the second time. He has extensively traveled to developed and developing countries of the world. He regularly participates in various national and international academic forums and contributes to policy dialogues on agriculture and rural development through both print and electronic media.

Professor Mandal is married and has a happy family of four members with one son and one daughter.
